She will be available to see patients at the clinic every Thursday.

Leavens has been a healthcare provider in the Ruby Valley for the past eleven years. When she first moved to the area, she worked at the Twin Bridges Clinic for two years. She worked with Dr. Googe and the Community Health Center for the next nine years. “I’m sad to see the CHC in Sheridan close. However, I’m pleased that I will have the opportunity to continue seeing my Ruby Valley patients at the clinic in Sheridan,” says Leavens.

After earning her Bachelor’s and Master’s of Science degrees in nursing at the University of Washington, Leavens completed a fellowship in Children with Special Healthcare Needs. Also in Washington, she worked for three years at Harborview Medical Center Childrens and Teens Clinic and Swedish Hospital. In addition to her pediatric credentials, Leavens is a lactation consultant. “We are very fortunate that Dayna has agreed to join our team,” says Ruby Valley Clinic physician, Roman Hendrickson. “She is one of six CPNPs in Montana.”
